New Research on the State of Discipleship Research Releases in Leaders & Pastors

- If the second doing very well at discipling new and young believers."
- 60% of church leaders feel that churches are discipling "not too well".
- 8% say their own church is doing "very well"
- 56% say their own church is doing "somewhat well at discipling new and young believers."
- 20% of Christian adults are involved in some sort of discipleship activity
